

- *Josiah Rice* b. 6 Sep 1696 Sudbury, MA; d. 28 Mar 1730 Worcester, MA
- *Ephraim Rice* b. 15 Apr 1665 Marlborough, MA; d. 25 Oct 1732 Sudbury, MA
- *Thomas Rice* bapt. 26 Jan 1625/25 Stanstead, Suffolk; d. 16 Nov 1681 Sudbury, MA
- *Edmund Rice* b. ~1594 Suffolk, England; d. 3 May 1663 Sudbury, MA




Stephen Rice's Children & Vital Info

- Children with Lucy Baker (1772-1804) m. 4 Oct 1799
 - *Harvey Rice, b. 11 Jun 1800 Conway, MA; d. 7 Nov 1891 Cleveland, OH
 - Harry Rice, b. Nov 1802 Conway, MA; d. 18 Aug 1803 Conway, MA
 - Harry Rice, b. 2 Aug 1804 Conway, MA; d. young, probably Conway, MA
 - Elihu Rice, bapt. 1805 Conway, MA; d. after 1841 (probable twin with 2nd Harry as mother Lucy died on 2 Aug 1804 in childbirth)
- Child with Abigail Freeman (1773-1836) m. 27 Feb 1814
 - *Henry Freeman "Harry" Rice, b. 19 Jul 1818 Conway, MA; d. 22
 Nov 1877 Stockton, CA

- Began career in the 1830s in Boston in the express cargo & insurance businesses; moved to Cleveland with relatives in the 1840s & engaged in coal and shipping businesses
- Moved to Carson City, NV in early 1850s with Comstock Lode silver discovery
- Served as Wells Fargo station manager, & elected as mayor
- A Democrat, but appointed by President Grant as postmaster (1869) and superintendent of Carson City Mint (1870). Controversially resigned mint superintendency 1873.
- Formed a securities trading firm in 1873, but was short lived, failing in 1877 due to 1870s Global Depression
- Traveled to Stockton, CA for medical treatment & died there while under treatment possible suicide.



Henry F. Rice's Family

- Married Jennie E. Hume (ca1820-ca1887) of Maitland, Nova Scotia, Canada on 31 Aug 1853 (she is lightly documented)
- Had son, Henry Hume Rice, b. 2 Aug 1854 in Maitland, NS; was railroad engineer *Virginia & Truckee RR* & known as "Lightning Harry"; m. 14 Jun 1881 to Delia B. Duffy (1863-1906); d. 21 Dec, 1899 Carson City, NV; wife Delia died 8 May 1906 Goldfield, NV with the name of Dyer.





- A.B. Williams College 1824; Studied law in Ohio tutored by jurist Reuben Wood & admitted to Ohio bar 1826 & law partnered with Wood
- Started newspaper *The Independent News Letter* in 1828, became managing editor; reorganized as *The Cleveland Plain Dealer* in 1842
- Elected to Ohio House of Representatives in 1830 for one term; appointed as agent for sale of Western Reserve Lands for \$150K, used to start Ohio public school system
- Elected to Ohio Senate 1851 for one term; led reorganization of Ohio public schools and began the public library system.
- Served on the Cleveland City Council in the late 1850s and was a writer in later life.



Portrait of Emma Maria Fitch (Woods) Rice Wife of Harvey Rice in 1847 by Allen Smith







- Began classical studies at *Western Reserve College* and *Preparatory School* in 1848 but no earned degree
- In 1850 became private secretary to father's law partner & Ohio Governor Reuben Wood.
- In 1853 began business w/ brother-in-law Proctor Burnett in porcelain ware importing; remained until retirement in 1889
- Served in Civil War as the Captain of the Cleveland Light Artillery Company
- Was active in civic affairs in Cleveland, serving as trustee in the Water Works Association and member of the Board of Elections
- Served on Board of Trustees for *Society for Savings* (now *Key Bank*)
- Was known as an avid yachtsman on Lake Erie and Commodore of the Yacht Club.



Family of Fannie Maria *Rice* Burnett (1832-1888)





- Fannie Maria Rice b. 1 Jan 1832 Cleveland; m. Proctor Rollin Burnett 30 Dec 1857 Cleveland d. 29 May 1888 Cleveland.
- *Proctor Rollin Burnett* b. 6 Nov 1828 Newberry, Geauga County, OH to Josiah C. Burnett (1797-1885) and Diadema Johnson Burnett (1798-1870); d. 14 Mar 1864 Cleveland. Was partner w/ Percy Rice in the fine china and home goods import business *Rice & Burnett Company* (1854-1892) (source: 1892 PRB probate files)
- Their son, *Rollin Proctor Burnett* b. 1 Feb 1862 in Cleveland; d. 3 Aug 1922 Cleveland reported as suicide; m. 4 Oct 1884 Lillian A. Spear (b. Jan 1862; d. 7 Jun 1892 Cleveland) m. Maria Rattinger Hoefling 21 Feb 1893 (b. Dec 1861 Germany; d. 8 Nov 1933 Cleveland); Burnett worked for the Cleveland, Columbus, Cincinnati and Indianapolis Railway; was a road construction contractor

- Born 16 Feb 1841 in Cleveland, OH to Harvey & Emma Maria Rice
- Married James Irvine on 25 Jul 1866 in Cleveland
- Moved to San Francisco after marriage
- Had two sons, James Harvey Irvine & Harvey Rice Irvine
- Died 23 Oct 1874 (same month as younger son)
- Burial at Cypress Lawn Memorial Park, Colma, CA

- Born 27 Dec 1827 in Anahilt, Down County, Northern Ireland
- Left Ireland in 1845 due to potato famine
- After 2 yrs in NYC, sailed to CA in 1848 & joined in gold rush in Calaveras County as miner & merchant
- In 1854 purchased a SF grocery wholesale house & named it Irvine & Co.; did business with Rice & Burnett Co. in Cleveland
- Soon began investing in SF real estate; In 1864 partnered with Lewellyn Bixby, Thomas & Benjamin Flint to purchase the 48,800-acre Rancho San Joaquin in 1864 and the 47,200-acre Rancho Lomas de Santiago in 1866 was the start of their ranch operations in Southern California.
- Married Nettie Rice in Cleveland on 25 Jul 1866
- Died 16 Mar 1886 in San Francisco




Mary Wood Rice (1844-1931)

- *Mary Wood Rice* b. 6 Nov 1844 Cleveland, OH; d. 1931 Cleveland; m. 7 July 1869 *Edward Payson Hunt* in Cleveland; b. 5 Jul 1838 Aurelius NY to *Harry Hunt* (1805-1886) and *Cynthia Yale Hunt*; was a hardware dealer in Cleveland per 1900 census; d. 31 Oct 1923
 - *Emma Maria Hunt* b. 2 May 1872 Cleveland; d. 2 Dec 1955 Ohio; m. 28 Nov 1900 to *Edwin Ruthven Perkins II* at Wyckliff, OH; b. 23 Apr 1879 in Ohio; d. 26 Jan 1960 at Columbus, NC. He was banker & railroad executive & philanthropist in Cleveland.
 - *Mary Nettie Hunt* b. 8 May 1877 Cleveland; d. 19 Feb 1964 Cleveland; m. 29 Jan 1913 to *Joseph Edgar Cook, MD*; b. 13 Feb 1856 Perry, OH; d. 31 May 1932 in Cleveland.
 - *Edwin Payson Hunt Jr.* b. 8 May 1877 Cleveland; d. Jul 1878 Cleveland.

James S. Rice Family Biographical Notes

- James S. Rice worked in Cleveland with brother-in-law Proctor Burnett at the Rice & Burnett Company; moved to California in January 1877. First residing in an adobe near Newport Bay built by the Sepúlveda family; first to plant oranges & muscat grapes in Tustin. Was engaged in land speculation and active in OC politics.
- Coralinn Barlow Rice's brother Charles Averill Barlow was a member of the US House of Reps from the CA-6 District for one term 1897-99 from the Populist Party
- *Percy Fitch Rice* was an inventor who patented several devices, including an automatic paper feeding device for printing presses, an automatic transmission for automobiles, the push-button radio tuner, the gasoline gauge for the automobile and a multiple exposure camera

- James Stephen Rice b. 31 Oct 1846 Cleveland; d. 15 Apr 1930 Tustin CA; m. 2 Oct 1872 Cleveland to Coralinn Barlow.
- Coralinn Frances Barlow b. Jan 1849 to Merrill Barlow (1824-1872) of Woodstock, CT and Anne Frances Arnold Barlow (1828-1908) of Cranston, RI; d. 25 Nov 1919 in Los Angeles, CA
 - James Willis Rice b. 24 Aug 1873 Cleveland; d. 7 Dec 1951 Orange County, CA; m. Ruebel Martin b. 31 Oct 1882 in Nevada daughter of John H. Martin, a Nevada state senator & his wife Catherine; d. 28 Sep 1966 in Orange County, CA.
 - *Merrill Barlow Rice* b. 25 Feb 1876 Cleveland; d. 14 April 1919 Riverside, CA; m. 1906 *Mary Burnham* California (ERA); Rice was an automobile mechanic.
 - *Harvey Rice* b. 20 May 1878 Tustin CA; d. Mar 1900 Tustin. Never married.
 - *Percy Fitch Rice* b. 25 Nov 1882 Tustin CA; d. 25 May 1954 in Orange County. Never married.
